

Before you begin

The following procedure will only work if the motor is programmed correctly with multiple blinds operating independently on separate channels.

If your blinds are not operating independently on separate channels, then we recommend you carry out a reset & reprogram procedure per blind and assign the correct channel sequence when programming.

ASSIGNING A CHANNEL FOR GROUP BLIND CONTROL

The following procedure will copy & paste an already paired channel to a spare channel on the multi-channel control Example — a 3 blind system, with blinds 1 to 3 currently paired to channels 1 to 3 - group control wanted on channel 5

Set the motor into pairing mode

Select the channel currently operating the blind independently (e.g. channel 1).



PRESS & HOLD the program button on the control until the blind

jogs – then release the program button:



Pair to the selected group channel

Select the spare channel you want to assign for group channel control (e.g. channel 5).



BRIEFLY PRESS & RELEASE the program button on the control - the blind jogs: The blind has been assigned to the group channel.



Follow the same procedure as above to assign additional channels

Set the motor into pairing mode

Select another channel operating a different blind (e.g. channel 2).



PRESS & HOLD the program button on the control until the blind

jogs – then release the program button:



Pair to the selected group channel

2 Select the spare channel you want to assign for group channel control (e.g. channel 5).



BRIEFLY PRESS & RELEASE the program button on the control - the blind jogs: The blind has been assigned to the group channel.
